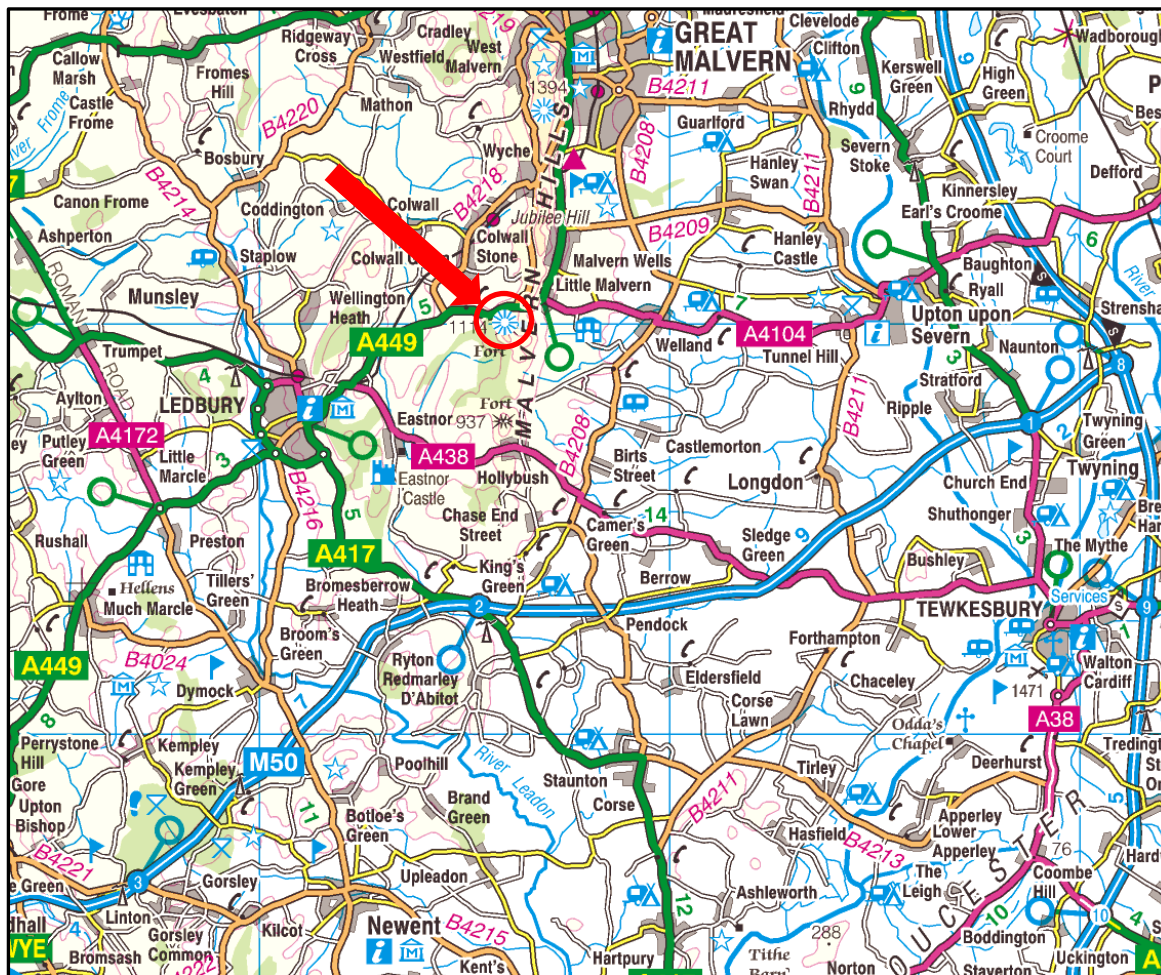


The Malvern Hills, A Geological Viewpoint

Meet 9:30 sharp at Herefordshire Beacon (British Camp) car park. We will walk the length of the ridge south to Chase End Hill. Along the way we will discuss every period in geological time from the Neoproterozoic to the Quaternary, using the rocks on the hills, or those within clear view (hopefully!) to illustrate the geological history. A picnic lunch (bring your own) will be taken at Gullet Quarry. We expect to get to finish at 16:00 and a minibus will take attendees back to the start. The walk will be as relaxed and paced as possible but obviously there will be some rough ground and steep muddy tracks in places. Total walking distance is about 6 miles. It is intended for nearly all ages and levels of geology. Hammering is not permitted. Make sure you have appropriate clothing and footwear.
